ASSUMPTIONS

- 1 Those Youth who participate in evidence-based interventions & education with PYD approach to voluntarily refrain from non-marital sexual activity and pledge to abstain from sexual behavior will do so.
- 2 Those Youth who gain and practice risk avoidance skills will abstain from sexual activity before marriage and related risky behaviors.

ENVIRONMENT

- Many single-parent households.
- Poor school achievement for the majority of adolescents and high dropout rate.
- High crime areas. •High repeat adolescent pregnancies.
- Poor involvement of the parents in school and other activities developed for adolescents.
